

## Keio Housing Application for International Students in Spring Semester 2012

Keio University has off-campus rooms for international students. If you are interested in staying in one of the Keio dormitories, read carefully the information below before applying. Please note that we cannot guarantee that all of the applicants will be granted a room as the number of rooms is limited.

### 1 . Qualification:

International students who (expect to) study at Keio University in 2012 academic year, and hold a college student status visa in principle.

\* Students who live in the JASSO dormitories and company housing (shain-ryo) cannot apply. (Those who can apply if they want to move in after their current lease expire.)

\* Students who have already lived for one year or more in Keio housing (now or in the past) are able to apply, but we assign high priority to freshman.

### 2 . Housing List: We have some rooms available at the dormitory below.

\* Period of residence: from March 22, 23, 2012 to July 31, 2012 or February 28, 2013

### 3 . Application deadline: **February 14, 2012 (Japan time)**

\*The deadline for the online registration cannot be changed under any circumstances, even regarding computer troubles.

### 4 . Application method:

Applicants for Keio housing must register online on the website below.

You do not have to submit any documents (application materials) except this online registration.

\*Please apply only once. After applying, if there are any changes to your application, please email the Office of Student Services immediately, including your full name and details of the changes.

### 5 . Method/Schedule of notification:

The Office of Student Services will inform all the applicants by e-mail whether or not their applications are approved by **February 27, 2012.**

When there are many applicants, students admitted to Keio University in April 2012 or students who have not lived in Keio dormitories in the past have first priority. Then we hold a lottery for the rest of the applicants.

### 6 . Notes:

- You cannot visit our accommodations/ rooms before you are approved to move in. For further information on housing including photos, please refer to the website above.

- You cannot request a particular room. All rooms will be assigned by the Office of Student Services according to availability. You also cannot change your room once it's assigned. The room number will be informed when you move in.
