<p>Requirements for Applicants</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Must have completed the Scholarship Applicant Registration for Spring Semester 2019 academic year within the designated period.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Must have a grade point average (*GPA) of <u>2.30 or more</u> in the previous academic year. Application Form for 2018 Academic Year Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students.</li> <li>2. Checklist for Monbukagakusho Honors Scholarship for Privately Financed International Students</li> <li>3. A copy of your Residence Card</li> <li>4. <u>A copy of Reservation Notice if you are a reservation holder, such as undergraduate students by EJU (Examination for Japanese University) admission.</u></li> <li>5. Documents attesting to the financial supporter's income if you have one in Japan.</li> <li>6. A copy of documents to prove your language proficiency requirements</li> </ol>

\*Students who have been recommended but not selected yet to private scholarship foundations are eligible to apply for the Honors Scholarship.

\*Final selection will be made by the government (Monbukagakusho). Note that you may not be selected even if you are recommended by Keio University.
