Winter Abroad at Yonsei

**** Early Bird Reward (Fee-Paying Students Only)**

- 1st Early Bird Reward (KRW 400,000) KRW 400,000 will be deducted from the total tuition for those successfully register and pay the tuition by October 31 (Sun).
- 2 2nd Early Bird Reward (KRW 200,000) KRW 200,000 will be deducted from the total tuition for those successfully register and pay the tuition by November 19 (Fri).

*** Benefits (Fee-Paying Students Only)**

- **BEATOGETHER COVID-19 (KRW 150,000 per online course)** Including the case of total switch to online due to ongoing pandemic, for those taking online courses, KRW 150,000 per course will be awarded.
- 2 Early Enrollment Benefit (KRW 100,000) All students who complete their application for 2021-22 Winter Abroad at Yonsei (WAY) by September 30 are eligible to receive a fee benefit and it will be deducted from the tuition fee.
- 3 Re-Enrollment Benefit (KRW 100,000) All students who have participated in the YISS or WAY program in the past is eligible to receive a fee benefit and it will be deducted from the tuition fee.
- 4 APRU & AEARU Associate University Scholarship (KRW 100,000) All students who are enrolled in the APRU and AEARU associate university will receive the APRU & AEARU scholarship and it will be deducted from the tuition fee.
 - *Please be informed that Early Bird Reward and other scholarships cannot be duplicated except BEATOGETHER COVID-19 scholarship.

* Payment Method

- 1 Wire Transfer: Wire transfer information will be provided by email after the online application is submitted.
- 2 Card Payment: Credit/ Debit cards that are issued overseas are accepted (Visa, Master and JCB).

* Housing (Optional)

Because on-campus housing is not guaranteed for all students due to the limited availability, housing is allotted on a first-come, first-served basis. Students are strongly recommended to apply for housing as soon as possible through the housing website dorm.yonsei.ac.kr after receiving your acceptance email.



Yonsei University is located in the center of the capital city of South Korea, Seoul, where you can witness a variety of traditional Korean culture. In addition to Korea's first Western health institution. Gwanghyewon which is located within the university, there are other nearby sites where you can experience traces of the 500-year history of the Joseon Dynasty, such as Deoksu-gung, Changdeokgung, and Gyeongbok-gung.
