**2026 Spring Semester Application Outline of Tutorial Services for International Students  
(Academic Dissertation Tutor/JLP Japanese Language Tutor/Student Life Support Tutor)**

This information is based on the “Regulations Regarding Tutorial Services for International Students.”

### 1. Purpose

To offer individual academic guidance outside of regular class hours to International students whose status of residence is “Student” so they may:

- a) acquire knowledge and skills in their specific fields of study via their scientific research
- b) improve their Japanese language proficiency
- c) receive assistance with their student life

\*Throughout this outline and procedures, we align with the “Regulations Regarding Tutorial Services for International Students” and we distinguish the personal tutors eligible for teaching the International student’s field of study as the “Academic Dissertation Tutor,” the Japanese language tutors eligible for teaching Japanese as the “JLP Japanese Language Tutor,” and students

supporting the International student's everyday life as the "Student Life Support Tutor."

### 4. Application

The academic advisor of the international student applies via the "Attendance managing system for temporary staff member" (<https://jswrkgt.adst.keio.ac.jp/en>) available at keio.jp

<Please submit the following documents in pdf format via the above system where applicable>

- (1) A copy of both sides of the residence card (if the tutor's nationality is other than Japanese)
- (2) Notice of status of residence (if the tutor's nationality is other than Japanese)
- (3) Statement of Reason (If the tutor does not meet the qualification requirements due to reasons such as mismatches of majors, status of residence that is not "Student," etc. submission of a "Statement of Reason" will be necessary)

### 5. Application Deadline

**Thursday, March 26, 2026 12:00pm (JST)**

Please make your best effort to apply before the above deadline. However, upon circumstances such as difficulties occurring due to the international student or tutor entering in Spring 2026, applications will be available **until Thursday, April 9, 2026 12:00pm (JST).**

### 6. Notice of Employment

After "4. Application," the Human Resources Department will accept the application. Within 3 to 4 days, the "Notice of Working Conditions" will be sent to the e-mail address of the tutor.

\*It would be greatly appreciated if the academic advisor may hand the "Attached Document 2" to the responsible tutor beforehand, so the tutor may commence with the following procedures smoothly.
