<p>Requirements for Applicants</p>	<p><input type="checkbox"/> Must have completed the Scholarship Applicant Registration for Spring Semester 2021 academic year within the designated period.</p> <p><input type="checkbox"/> Must have a grade point average (*GPA) of <u>2.30 or more</u> in the previous academic year. *Students who have been recommended but not selected yet to private scholarship foundations are eligible to apply for the Honors Scholarship.

*Final selection will be made by the government (Monbukagakusho). Note that you may not be selected even if you are recommended by Keio University.

*Although you are selected as a recipient by the government, you will not receive a monthly scholarship if you are outside of Japan at the moment (After you come to Japan, you will receive a monthly scholarship if your enrollment is confirmed.).
