## CEMS rises one place to 11<sup>th</sup> in the QS 2024 Masters in Management (MiM) ranking

CEMS MIM ranked 11<sup>th</sup> out of 201

The CEMS MIM is ranked in the top 5.5% globally with an overall score of 86.4 out of 100 in the QS 2024 MiM ranking. The MIM performed particularly strongly in the value for money indicator group scoring an impressive 96.8 out of 100, the global average was 61.7.

CEMS scored consistently higher that than the global average across all indicator groups. Out of a possible one hundred CEMS scored 84.7 for diversity (global average 63.9), 82.9 for though leadership (global average 51.9), 82.6 for employability (global average 49.6) and 79.5 for alumni outcomes (global average 48.7).
